In accordance with Section 70(1) of the Gambling Control Act 2022, the Gambling Regulatory Authority of Singapore approves the game rules in respect of the game “Horse Race Betting” as set out in this document by Singapore Pools (Private) Limited.

GAME RULES FOR HORSE RACE BETTING ("HORSE RACE BETTING GAME RULES")

The following Rules are laid down by Singapore Pools (Private) Limited ("Singapore Pools", "we", "us" or "our") for Horse Race Betting.

1. Objective

- 1.1 A horse race is essentially a competition in which a number of horses typically ridden by jockeys compete over a set distance on a race track.
- 1.2 The game of betting on horse races offered by Singapore Pools ("**Horse Race Betting**") involves the placing of bets in respect of horse races. The betting utilises a totalisator format, i.e. all bets of a particular type are placed together in a pool, and this pool is distributed among winning bets (less taxes and commissions). In Horse Race Betting, the prize which you may win when you have placed a bet on a winning combination / selection is otherwise known as "**winnings**".
- 1.3 The horse races which Singapore Pools offers for betting are conducted overseas by overseas turf clubs.

2. How to Play

- 2.1 In Horse Race Betting, you are essentially placing wagers on possible outcomes relating to one or more horse races.
- 2.2 In each horse race, the horses selected to run the race may or may not participate in the race for various reasons. Therefore, horses not participating in the race (such as "scratched" horses¹) and/or horses which are deemed to be withdrawn from the race at any time (whether during the course or after the completion of the race) may be declared to be "**non-starters**" by the stewards in accordance with the applicable rules made or adopted by the overseas turf clubs for the conduct and control of horse racing (the "**Rules of Racing**"). Conversely, the horses which are participating in the race and which have not been declared as withdrawn at any time are termed as "**starters**". Each horse is also denominated and identified by a number on their saddle cloth, and this number is otherwise known as the "horse No." or "starter number", both of which are used interchangeably in this set of rules.
- 2.3 For each horse race, the horses are ranked according to how favoured they are to win in the race, as assessed by the total amount of money validly wagered on the horses ("**stake**") in the particular race in Win Betting (as defined and explained in **Appendix A1 of the Appendix to Horse Race Betting Game rules – Bet Types**) at the close of betting. The horse garnering the highest amount of money validly

staked on it is ranked as the “**favourite**” or the “**1st favourite**”, the horse with the next highest amount of money validly staked on it shall be ranked as the “**2nd favourite**”, and so on. In the event that two or more horses have the same amount of money staked on them, the horse with a lower horse number in the official race programme will be deemed to have a larger total amount of money validly staked on it than the horse(s) with a higher number.

- 2.4 In horse racing, it is typical for two or more horses to be included in what is commonly known as a “**bracket**”. A bracket simply refers to a starter number which denominates and identifies two or more horses. For example, horses No. 8 and 10 may be included under the same starter number 10. The horses included in a bracket are therefore known as “**bracketed starters**”. This is important as some of the bet types under these Horse Race Betting Game Rules allow you to place bets on a bracket number, instead of individual horses. Singapore Pools, shall at our sole and absolute discretion, determine which of the starters in a race are bracketed starters, and which starter number is allocated to the bracketed starters. Such allocation by Singapore Pools of the bracketed starters shall be to the exclusion of any allocation by the overseas turf club or totalisator operator.
- 2.5 Various bet types under these Horse Race Betting Game Rules also require you to place your betting selections across multiple races. In such cases, the races are grouped together for betting purposes, and each nominated race is known as a “**leg**”. The first of the nominated races to be run in the group of races is known as the “**1st leg**”, the second of such races to be run is termed the “**2nd leg**” and so on.

3. Placing your bets

- 3.1 When placing bets, you will have to choose the type of the bet and the method of the bet you wish to place.

A. *Bet Types*

- 3.2 At present, the types of bets available for Horse Race Betting are:

- (i) Win Betting;
- (ii) Place Betting;
- (iii) Evens and Odds Betting;
- (iv) Forecast Betting;
- (v) Place Forecast Betting;
- (vi) Tierce Betting;
- (vii) Trio Betting;
- (viii) Quartet Betting;
- (ix) Quadro Betting;
- (x) Double Betting;
- (xi) Double Forecast Betting;
- (xii) Double Trio Betting;
- (xiii) Triple Trio Betting;
- (xiv) Six Up Betting;
- (xv) All Up Betting; and
- (xvi) Roll Betting

Singapore Pools may, from time to time, vary the list of bet types available for Horse Race Betting at our sole and absolute discretion. The rules applicable to each of the aforesaid bet types are set out in the “**Appendix to Horse Race Betting Game Rules – Bet Types**” hereto.

B. Methods of Betting

3.3 At present, the available methods of betting are as follows:

- (a) **Banker betting:** This means the method of betting where you select a bet type and the various horses you wish to bet on for that bet type. In addition, you will have to select a horse or horses nominated as the “banker” or “bankers”. By making a banker bet, you are essentially placing multiple individual bets of that bet type containing the “banker” or “bankers” together with all permutations of the remaining non-banker horses. The “banker” or “bankers” selected must win in order for the rest of your bet to be successful, i.e. if your “banker” or “bankers” lose, the rest of your bet will lose regardless of the actual outcomes of the underlying races. Winnings are computed based on evaluating whether each individual bet of that bet type placed is a winning bet, and what the payout of that winning bet will be in accordance with the rules applicable to that bet type.

Example 1: In Trio Betting, if you place a banker bet with horse No. 1 as the banker, with horses No. 2, 3 and 4 as the non-banker horses, you will be deemed to have placed a bet on horses No. 1, 2 and 3, a bet on horses No. 1, 2 and 4 and a bet on horses No. 1, 3 and 4.

Example 2: In Trio Betting, if you place a banker bet with horse No. 1 and 2 as the bankers, with horses No. 3 and 4 as the non-banker horses, you will be deemed to have placed a bet on horses No. 1, 2 and 3 and a bet on horses No. 1, 2 and 4. As there are two bankers, this is also known as Double Banker.

An illustration of the bet combinations / selections of banker betting can be found at **Appendix to Horse Race Betting Game Rules – Bet Combinations / Selections**.

- (b) **Box betting:** This means the method of betting where you bet on all the permutations of the horses selected for a race or one or more legs for bet types involving multiple races. Each permutation will be considered an individual bet placed for that bet type.

Example 1: In Trio Betting, if you place a box bet for horses No. 1, 2, 3 and 4, you will be placing bets on all the different permutations of the selected horses for Trio Betting, i.e. you will be deemed to have placed a bet on horses No. 1, 2 and 3, a bet on horses No. 1, 2 and 4, a bet on horses No. 1, 3 and 4 and a bet on horses No. 2, 3 and 4.

Example 2: In Double Forecast Betting, if you place a bet on horses No. 1 and No. 2 for the 1st leg and a box bet for horses No. 1, 2, 3 and 4 for the 2nd leg, you will be placing bets on all the different permutations of the selected horses for the 2nd leg, i.e. you will be deemed to have placed a bet

on horses No. 1 and 2, a bet on horses No. 1 and 3, a bet on horses No. 1 and 4, a bet on horses No. 2 and 3, a bet on horses No. 2 and 4 and a bet on horses No. 3 and 4 for the 2nd leg.

An illustration of the bet combinations / selections for various bet types (non-exhaustive) of box betting can be found at **Appendix to Horse Race Betting Game Rules – Bet Combinations / Selections**.

(c) **Field betting:** This means the method of betting where you place a bet on either of the following:

- i. **For a bet on one race:** the inclusion into a combination / selection with one or more of the declared starters and whether singly or in permutation (as required for the bet type) all other or the remaining declared starters (as required for the bet type) for that race;

Example 1: In Win Betting, if you place a field betting bet for a race with eight (8) horses, you will be placing bets on all the different permutations of the selected horses, i.e. you will be deemed to have placed a bet on horse No. 1, a bet on horse No. 2, a bet on horse No. 3, a bet on horse No. 4, a bet on horse No. 5, a bet on horse No. 6, a bet on horse No. 7 and a bet on horse No. 8.

Example 2: In Tierce Betting, if you place a field betting bet for a race with 7 horses and you specify horse No. 1 to finish in 1st place and horse No. 2 to finish in 2nd place, you will be placing bets on all the different permutations for the 3rd place finish as follows:

Combination 1: [Horse No. 1 (1st); Horse No. 2 (2nd); Horse No. 3 (3rd)]

Combination 2: [Horse No. 1 (1st); Horse No. 2 (2nd); Horse No. 4 (3rd)]

Combination 3: [Horse No. 1 (1st); Horse No. 2 (2nd); Horse No. 5 (3rd)]

Combination 4: [Horse No. 1 (1st); Horse No. 2 (2nd); Horse No. 6 (3rd)]

Combination 5: [Horse No. 1 (1st); Horse No. 2 (2nd); Horse No. 7 (3rd)]

- ii. **For a bet involving multiple legs of a nominated race:** a bet in which in any one or more of the legs requires the inclusion into a combination / selection with one or more of the declared starters in a leg and whether singly or in permutation (as required for the bet type) all other or the remaining declared starters (as required for the bet type) in that leg.

Example: In Double Betting in a race with 6 horses, if you place a field betting bet for a race with 6 horses and you specify horse No. 3 to finish in 1st place for the 1st leg, you will be placing bets on all the different permutations for the winner of the 2nd leg, such that your Double Betting bets will be as follows:

Combination 1: [Horse No. 3 (1st); Horse No. 1 (1st)]

Combination 2: [Horse No. 3 (1st); Horse No. 2 (1st)]
 Combination 3: [Horse No. 3 (1st); Horse No. 3 (1st)]
 Combination 4: [Horse No. 3 (1st); Horse No. 4 (1st)]
 Combination 5: [Horse No. 3 (1st); Horse No. 5 (1st)]
 Combination 6: [Horse No. 3 (1st); Horse No. 6 (1st)]

- (d) **Lucky Pick or Computer Pick:** This means once you have selected your bet type, a bet for that bet type is randomly generated by the computer for you.
- (e) **System betting:** This means the method of betting where you select one or more horses for each of the places for bets which require the selection of two or more placed horses. The unit bet for a system bet of a bet type is the unit bet of that bet type multiplied by the total number of possible bets of that bet type that can be placed based on your selection. For example, in Forecast Betting where you have to select the 1st and 2nd placed horses in the race, you're able to place multiple selections for the 1st placed horse and multiple selections for the 2nd placed horse through system betting, e.g. horses No. 6, 8, 11 to be the 1st placed horse and horses No. 2, 7, 10 to be the 2nd placed horse. Based on your selection, you are placing individual bets of Forecast Betting on each of these nine combinations / selections:

Combination 1: [Horse no. 6 (1st); Horse no. 2 (2nd)]
 Combination 2: [Horse no. 6 (1st); Horse no. 7 (2nd)]
 Combination 3: [Horse no. 6 (1st); Horse no. 10(2nd)]
 Combination 4: [Horse no. 8 (1st); Horse no. 2 (2nd)]
 Combination 5: [Horse no. 8 (1st); Horse no. 7 (2nd)]
 Combination 6: [Horse no. 8 (1st); Horse no. 10 (2nd)]
 Combination 7: [Horse no. 11 (1st); Horse no. 2 (2nd)]
 Combination 8: [Horse no. 11 (1st); Horse no. 7 (2nd)]
 Combination 9: [Horse no. 11 (1st); Horse no. 10 (2nd)]

The unit bet for your system bet would be the unit bet of Forecast Betting multiplied by nine.

C. Events affecting your bets

3.4 In the context of Horse Race Betting:

- a) a “**betting pool**” refers to the total dollar value of the bets placed by players / bettors for each type of betting.
- b) a combination / selection which is “**unbacked**” refers to a combination / selection on which no monies have been validly staked;
- c) a “**meeting**” refers to a group of horse races conducted as a single racing programme; and
- d) a “**zone**” refers to a wider geographic area containing one or more meetings as set out in the table below.

- 3.5 You are able to place your bets for Horse Race Betting either (a) physically at our betting outlets or our selected authorised retailers² or our betting centres where live broadcasts of races can be viewed or (b) remotely through our website or mobile app. If a bet is successfully placed physically at our betting outlets or our selected authorised retailers or our betting centres, you will receive a physical betting ticket, which will serve as proof that your bet has been validly placed. If a bet is successfully placed through your verified account that is opened and operated by Singapore Pools for the purpose of remote betting (“**Remote Betting Account**”) via the Singapore Pools website and mobile app, you will receive a confirmation that your bet has been successfully placed. The bet will be recorded in your Remote Betting Account, and such record will serve as proof that your bet has been validly placed. Your bet will be deemed to be valid and accepted by Singapore Pools only if full payment has been made for the requisite stake amount for your bet. If such

full payment is not made, the bet will be invalid and rejected by Singapore Pools. It is your responsibility to ensure that the data printed on the physical betting ticket, e-ticket, or recorded in the Remote Betting Account are in accordance with your instructions.

- 3.6 The number of bets for a particular type of betting for Horse Race Betting which you may make for any one pool may be restricted in such manner as we may deem fit at our sole and absolute discretion. The times allowed for the placement of bets shall also be determined by us at our sole and absolute discretion, and all bets must be placed not later than such times as may be fixed by us before the start of each particular race or first leg race.
- 3.7 Singapore Pools shall not be obligated to offer the same bet types and methods of betting available at any particular betting location for any one or more of the types of betting available for Horse Race Betting, notwithstanding that such types and systems may be available at other betting locations.
- 3.8 The placement of bets by participants in Horse Race Betting through the facilities made available by Singapore Pools is processed, consolidated and recorded by Singapore Pool's horse racing bet engine ("**HRB Engine**"). For purposes of calculating the betting pool (as defined at Clause 3.4(a) above) and the number of winning bets for a particular race, Singapore Pools' records of bets for the particular race as recorded by the HRB Engine shall be conclusive of the total number of valid bets placed and the details of each valid bet placed for the particular race. Such bets as recorded in the HRB Engine may include bets in respect of which, due to technical issues, system failures or any other reason, the relevant stake has not been paid to or accepted by Singapore Pools ("**Unpaid Bets**"). Singapore Pools shall make up for any shortfall in the betting pool attributable to such Unpaid Bets. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in these Rules, where such Unpaid Bets constitute winning bets, each of them shall, for purposes of calculating the pool and the number of winning bets for the particular horse race, be treated as a winning bet.
- 3.9 For each bet type, Singapore Pools shall determine at our sole and absolute discretion from time to time, the unit bet or flexibet (also commonly known as "partial unit bet"). The "**unit bet**" means the minimum amount fixed by us as the amount on which winnings will be calculated, and "**flexibet**" means the fraction of a unit bet and minimum amount which we will accept with respect to a particular bet type when the bets are placed.
- 3.10 A unit bet on a starter number having 2 bracketed starters shall cost the same as a unit bet on a starter number having only one starter.
- 3.11 The format and form of the betting ticket which includes both physical tickets issued offline for bets physically placed at our betting outlets or our selected authorised retailers or our betting centres, as well as e-tickets issued and digital records for bets placed via remote betting to be used for any particular bet type shall be determined by Singapore Pools at our sole and absolute discretion from time to time.

3.12 Government tax and commission payable to Singapore Pools under the Singapore Totalisator Board Act shall be deducted from each betting pool. The commission payable to Singapore Pools will depend on the specific bet type in question.

- a) Where Singapore Pools transmit pools of bets collected within Singapore to the overseas totalisator for the purposes of the overseas totalisator's operation of totalisator betting on overseas races with commingled betting pools, the commission payable to Singapore Pools will follow the commission rates as set by the relevant commingling partner from time to time.
- b) Where Singapore Pools receives the transmission of pools of bets collected by the overseas totalisators for the purposes of Singapore Pools' operation of totalisator betting on overseas races, Singapore Pools' commission for Win Betting, Place Betting, Forecast Betting, Place Forecasting Betting and Double Betting shall be 18%, and its commission for Tierce Betting, Trio Betting, Quartet Betting, Quadro Betting, Double Trio Betting and Triple Trio Betting shall be 25%.

3.13 Singapore Pools may declare a minimum guaranteed net pool amount for a particular betting pool. If the net betting pool is less than the minimum guaranteed net pool amount, Singapore Pools shall increase the net betting pool to match the minimum guaranteed net pool amount before the net betting pool is divided for the particular bet type, save where the net betting pool is less than the minimum guaranteed net pool amount for the following reasons:

- a) If one or more races are void;
- b) If there are insufficient starters or insufficient finishers in any leg of a nominated race for the particular bet type; or
- c) If one or more races are cancelled.

3.14 Singapore Pools may declare the addition of such sums of money to any net betting pool as it may decide in its sole and absolute discretion, and such money declared shall form part of the net betting pool subject to any applicable rules which may stipulate otherwise. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, in the event of one or more of the winning combinations / selections being unbacked, the net betting pool plus such money so declared by Singapore Pools shall be carried forward as a jackpot to the betting pool of the same bet type for the next scheduled race in the same meeting and where there are no longer any races scheduled in the meeting, to the next scheduled race in the same zone, unless the bets are in respect of a race belonging to a meeting other than those listed in the table at Clause 3.4 above, in which event Singapore Pools will inform you of which race the monies will be carried forward to via the Singapore Pools website, screen displays at our betting centres, and the Horse Racing Channel(s) available on Singapore television.

Illustration:

Taking the following hypothetical race schedule for the Australia zone:

Meeting and Race number	Date and Time of race

If the winning combination / selection for the Quadro Betting bet for the horse race in the Perth meeting Race 1 on 1 February 2023, 11:00AM is unbacked, the net betting pool for the Quadro Betting bet type shall be carried forward and added to the betting pool for the Quadro Betting bet type for the horse race in the Perth meeting Race 2 on 1 February 2023, 3:00PM.

If the winning combination / selection for the Quadro Betting bet type for the horse race in the Perth meeting Race 2 on 1 February 2023, 3:00PM is also unbacked, the net betting pool for the Quadro Betting bet type shall be carried forward and added to the betting pool for the Quadro Betting bet type for the horse race in the Melbourne meeting Race 2 on 1 February 2023, 4:00PM.

- 3.15 Details of bets placed at all betting locations will be transmitted and added to the relevant betting pools before the start of each race unless special circumstances require otherwise or because of unforeseen circumstances. When all or part of the bets placed at any betting location cannot be transmitted, recorded or added to the relevant betting pools due to unforeseen circumstances, Singapore Pools may, at our sole and absolute discretion, accept any such bets placed as qualifying for such winnings as may be determined by Singapore Pools.
- 3.16 Singapore Pools operates totalisator betting (whether commingled with overseas bets or otherwise) on racing in overseas horse races run under the Rules of Racing of the applicable overseas turf club.

D. Betting pools commingled with overseas bets

- 3.17 Singapore Pools shall be entitled to operate totalisator betting with commingled betting pools where Singapore Pools transmits pools of bets collected within Singapore to an overseas totalisator and/or receive pools of bets collected by an overseas totalisator for the purposes of forming the commingled betting pools. For the avoidance of doubt, Clause 3.8 above applies for the purposes of the calculation of the pools of investments collected within Singapore. SPPL may offer various commingled bet types with one or more the following partners, although SPPL does not guarantee the availability of any of the commingled bet types and shall not be responsible if any of the commingled bet types are not available for any reason or at any time³:

- 3.18 The rules in this section under “Betting pools commingled with overseas bets” shall be applicable only when Singapore Pools operates totalisator betting with commingled betting pools, and the other parts of these Horse Race Betting Game Rules shall continue to apply insofar as they are consistent with the rules herein. In the event of any such inconsistency, the rules in this section shall prevail.
- 3.19 Where Singapore Pools operates totalisator betting on overseas races with commingled betting pools in which Singapore Pools has transmitted pools of bets to an overseas totalisator, the rules of the overseas totalisator shall be applied to determine prize pools and winnings. The rules of each of the respective overseas totalisators can be found on the webpage pertaining to the commingling of horse racing on the Singapore Pools website domain. Singapore Pools shall only be obliged to pay out winnings as determined by the overseas totalisator in accordance with the rules of the latter or as otherwise conveyed by the overseas totalisator to Singapore Pools. Such winnings as determined by the overseas totalisator shall be final and conclusive.
- 3.20 Where Singapore Pools operates totalisator betting on overseas races with commingled betting pools in which Singapore Pools has received pools of bets collected by a third party overseas totalisator and such commingled betting pool is not transmitted to any overseas totalisator, Singapore Pools shall only be obliged to pay out winnings in accordance with these Horse Race Betting Game Rules and other terms and conditions which may be applicable to the payment of such winnings. The determination of such winnings by us shall be final and conclusive.
- 3.21 Where Singapore Pools operates totalisator betting on overseas races with commingled betting pools, winnings or refunds (if applicable) shall be paid out on such date, in such manner and at such location as we may determine at our sole and absolute discretion.

E. Other applicable terms

- 3.22 Not all methods and types of bets are available for each race. Singapore Pools reserves the right to change the available method and types of bets from time to time at our sole and absolute discretion.
- 3.23 Singapore Pools may, from time to time, determine the minimum number of declared starters necessary for the conduct of each particular bet type.
- 3.24 If one or more, but not all, of the starters in the same bracket are declared to be non-starter(s), all bets on the remaining bracketed starters shall continue to be valid to the exclusion of the non-starter horse(s).
- 3.25 Singapore Pools has the full discretion to determine the maximum number of bets that you may place from time to time. At the time of placing your bets, you will only be able to place up to this determined maximum number of bets.
- 3.26 Singapore Pools has full discretion to determine from time to time, the maximum and minimum limits of the stake that you may place, as well as any other conditions

attached to such stake as may be notified to you through the Singapore Pools website or mobile app.

4. Prizes – Declaration of Winnings

- 4.1 During the bet placement period for a particular horse race racing event, Singapore Pools may, at our sole and absolute discretion, publish the estimated or approximated winnings for each selection of a particular bet type, solely for reference purposes. For the avoidance of doubt:-
- a) Such published estimations or approximations of winnings shall not be binding on Singapore Pools, and Singapore Pools shall not be liable for any purported losses or damages suffered by you arising out of your reliance on such estimations or approximations;
 - b) The estimated or approximated winnings fluctuate on a real-time basis, and Singapore Pools make no representation or warranty as to the accuracy of such estimations or approximations;
 - c) The publication of the estimated or approximated winnings by Singapore Pools does not constitute any form of forecast as to the likelihood of chances that a particular selection would be a winning selection; and
 - d) The publication of the estimated or approximated winnings by Singapore Pools does not constitute any representation or warranty by Singapore Pools as to the winnings ultimately payable for any particular selection that turns out to be a winning selection.
- 4.2 Official information on the results of races will be released by us on the Singapore Pools website and mobile app as and when such results are available to us. We reserve the right to rectify any errors discovered after the official information has been released on the Singapore Pools website and mobile app, and the results of the races will be as stated in the latest rectified version on the Singapore Pools website and mobile app. Otherwise, the results of the relevant race shall be as announced on the Singapore Pools website and mobile app at the end of the relevant race.
- 4.3 In the event an “**objection**” is raised by stewards, horse owners, trainers or jockeys as to the result of a race, the betting pool shall not be divided and winnings shall not be declared until such objection has been resolved.
- 4.4 The race result after the “**all clear signal**” has been given shall be the final result used to determine whether winnings should be paid and the amount of such winnings, and it does not matter that the declared result may be altered as a result of any subsequent inquiry or action. Once the “**all clear signal**” has been given, the betting pool shall be divided and the winnings paid to persons with bets on the winning and placed horses as placed by the judge(s). No subsequent objection or breach of the Rules of Racing applicable to the overseas horse races in question or any irregularity whatsoever discovered subsequently shall disturb the original settlement, and you shall not have any claim whatsoever against Singapore Pools or the stewards in respect of such subsequent objection or breach of the Rules of Racing or any irregularity whatsoever discovered subsequently.

- 4.5 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in these Horse Race Betting Game Rules, where Singapore Pools operates totalisator betting on overseas races with only pools of investments collected within Singapore, it shall pay winnings based on the official race results first received by us from the overseas turf club. Such official race results are final and conclusive, and you shall not have any claim whatsoever against us arising from or in connection with such official race results.
- 4.6 Winnings shall be calculated from the total stakes of each betting pool registered on our official record, after the deduction of government tax and the commission payable to Singapore Pools pursuant to the Singapore Totalisator Board Act. Betting pools from bets placed on each bet type shall be calculated separately. The amount of winnings payable shall be calculated in accordance with these Horse Race Betting Game Rules, although Singapore Pools may, at our sole and absolute discretion, declare a minimum winning sum in respect of a winning bet from time to time.
- 4.7 Winnings will be declared based on the unit bet. Winnings on bets of higher value than the unit bet shall be in the same multiple of the winning declared on the unit bet as the higher value of bet is of the unit bet. For example, if you participate in Win Betting and place 2 unit bets on horse no. 4 as the winner of the race, and horse no. 4 comes in first in the race with a winning dividend of \$10 per unit bet, you shall receive \$20 as winnings.
- 4.8 Singapore Pools shall determine whether winnings will be declared in multiples of S\$1 (rounded down to the nearest dollar), or in fractions of a dollar on all or certain types of bets. For example, if you participate in Quartet Betting and place a flexibet of 0.5 unit bets on horses nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 to finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th respectively, and horses nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 come in 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th respectively with a winning dividend of \$75 per unit bet, and Singapore Pools has determined that winnings will be declared in multiples of S\$1 (rounded down to the nearest dollar), you shall receive \$37 as winnings.
- 4.9 If the total number of correct bets in the betting pool is less than a unit, the winning flexibets shall be paid winnings in such proportion of the net betting pool as the flexibets are of the same unit bet. The unpaid balance of the net betting pool shall be carried forward to the betting pool of the same bet type for the next scheduled race in the same meeting, and where there are no longer any races scheduled in that meeting, to the next scheduled race in the same zone unless the bets are in respect of a race belonging to a meeting other than those listed in the table at Clause 3.4 above, in which event Singapore Pools will inform you of which race the monies will be carried forward to via the Singapore Pools website, screen displays at our betting centres and the Horse Racing Channel(s) available on Singapore television.
- 4.10 Where any irregularity becomes apparent in respect of an official record or computer record subsequent to the declaration of winnings, Singapore Pools reserves to right to declare such winnings as void.
- 4.11 Notwithstanding Clause 4.10 above, where an error or miscalculation is discovered whereby the declared winning is changed (including where there has been an error or miscalculation), whether before or after all the customers/bettors have been paid the declared winnings, Singapore Pools shall be entitled to declare a revised winning. Any holders of winning tickets who have not previously encashed their

tickets shall be paid such revised winning notwithstanding the payment to other investors of a winning as previously declared.

- 4.12 Where a false start has been signalled, the winnings may be declared in the usual manner on the horses officially placed after the race has been run.

5. Irregularities

- 5.1 A race may be declared to be void by the stewards for any of the following reasons:

- a) It is void based on the Rules of Racing;
- b) If the race is abandoned either before or after the horses have been declared to start;
- c) If the race was never run; or
- d) If no horses are placed by the judge in accordance with the Rules of Racing.

The effect of a void race for each bet type is provided for at **Appendix to Horse Race Betting Game Rules – Bet Types**.

- 5.2 “**Scratching**” is the declaration of one or more horses as non-starters before the commencement of a race meeting. Where the stewards permit or authorise the scratching of a horse for whatsoever reason, including scratching of the horse on the basis of the stewards’ opinion that the horse to be scratched has been prevented from starting by the mechanical failure of the starting stalls or the starter failing to place the horse in its stall, the bet on the scratched horse shall be void and all monies placed for that bet shall be refunded unless otherwise provided in these Horse Race Betting Game Rules. In the event of any horse being scratched, the overseas turf club has the discretion as to whether or not to replace the scratched horse with a reserve horse (also known as an “emergency acceptor”), and if so, the allocation of the assigned starter number and/or stall for the emergency acceptor, if any. In any case, all bets on the affected horse race will stand and there will be no refund as a result of the scratching of any horse, save that bets on the scratched horse(s) and any other horse(s) which are otherwise deemed to be withdrawn shall be refunded.
- 5.3 Refunds are not available for any purchases made in respect of Horse Race Betting, save where provided for at **Appendix to Horse Race Betting Game Rules – Bet Types** for the particular bet type and elsewhere in these Horse Race Betting Game Rules. We will only grant refunds if we are satisfied at our sole and absolute discretion that your claim is valid.
- 5.4 If a false start is signalled before betting on the race has been closed, the betting may remain open. If betting has been closed prior to the false start being signalled, any or all betting on the race may be reopened for sale after notice of the false start is received.
- 5.5 If a race is declared void by the stewards and is ordered to be re-run under the Rules of Racing, all bets received on the void race shall be dealt with in accordance with these Horse Race Betting Game Rules. The re-run race shall be deemed as a new

race, and Singapore Pools shall have the sole and absolute discretion to determine which betting pool(s), if any, shall operate for the re-run race.

- 5.6 Where any error or miscalculation of any prize is discovered at any time, Singapore Pools shall be empowered at our sole and absolute discretion to declare a revised prize.
- 5.7 Where a revised prize is declared by Singapore Pools in respect of your winning betting ticket:
- a) If you have not previously been paid a prize in respect of your winning betting ticket, you shall be paid the full revised prize.
 - b) Where you have been paid the original prize and the revised prize is higher in value than the original prize, you shall be entitled to claim the difference between the original prize and the revised prize, subject to any reasonable conditions of payment which Singapore Pools may impose at our sole and absolute discretion.
 - c) If you have failed to present yourself for the collection of the revised prize or the difference between the original prize and the revised prize by the expiration of the time specified by Singapore Pools for the payment of the revised prize, or otherwise failed to adequately identify yourself to our satisfaction or to accept our conditions of payment (if any), the unclaimed revised prize or difference shall be forfeited.
 - d) Where you have been paid the original prize and the revised prize is lower in value than the original prize, Singapore Pools shall be entitled to recover the difference from you.
- 5.8 Where Singapore Pools operates totalisator betting on overseas races with commingled betting pools, we may at our sole and absolute discretion de-couple or abandon the betting pools, if for any reason whatsoever, we are unable to transmit pools of bets collected within Singapore to the overseas totalisator or if we are unable to receive the transmission of pools of bets collected by the overseas totalisator (as the case may be).

In the event of abandonment of betting pools, all bets placed will be void and refunded.

In the event of de-coupling of betting pools, no refunds shall be made and we shall pay out winnings on the pools of bets collected within Singapore in accordance with these Horse Race Betting Game Rules and other terms and conditions which may be applicable to the payment of such winnings. The determination of such winnings by us shall be final and conclusive. We shall not be liable to you for any losses that may result from such de-coupling.

6. General Provisions

- 6.1 These Horse Race Betting Game Rules shall apply to all bets placed on or after 6 July 2026.
- 6.2 By placing a bet for Horse Race Betting, you agree to be bound by these Horse Race Betting Game Rules and the Appendix.

APPENDIX TO HORSE RACE BETTING GAME RULES – BET TYPES

Appendix A1 - Win Betting

Bet Type	• “Win Betting” refers to the type of betting where you have to select the horse that comes in first in the race. In other words, the winning selection is the selection of the horse that comes in first in the race. • For example, if horse No. 4 placed first in the race, the winning selection is horse No. 4.
Winning Selection	• Selection of 1st placed horse in a race of 4 or more declared starters. • In the event that a bracketed starter comes in first in the race, the starter number allocated to the bracketed starter shall be the winning selection. • This is subject to the provisions on declaration(s) of non-starter, Dead Heat, insufficient finishers and void races below.
Unit Bet	The unit bet for Win Betting is \$5.
Minimum No. of Starters before bet type is offered	In the event of there being fewer than four (4) starters in a race, Win Betting will not be offered for the race.
In event of declaration(s) of non-starter	• In the event of any declaration(s) of non-starter, the bets on the non-starter selection(s) (as applicable) will be void and refunded. • In the event that the declaration(s) of non-starter results in there being fewer than four (4) starters in the race, this bet type will cease to be offered for the race, and all bets placed for this bet type will be void and refunded.
Dead Heat	• A “Dead Heat” refers to a situation where the performances of two or more horses are so close such that the result is declared a tie. Subject to the provisions below, in the event of a Dead Heat, winnings shall be paid on the horses which have run the Dead Heat. In such cases, the net betting pool for Win Betting shall be divided into as many equal parts as there are horses which are backed by bets running the Dead Heat, and each such part shall be divided by the respective number of unit bets on each of such horses. • Example 1: If horses No. 1, 2 and 3 tied for the first place in the race, the net betting pool for Win Betting will be divided equally between horses No. 1, 2 and 3, i.e. the pool will be divided by 3. Each sub-pool in respect of each horse is then divided into the number of unit bets placed on that horse, and bettors who have placed a bet on either of horses No. 1, 2 or 3 will have made a winning selection.

	• In the event of a Dead Heat between bracketed starters included in the same bracket, there shall only be a single winning which is payable with respect to each unit bet on the starter number of the bracketed starters running the Dead Heat. • In the event of a Dead Heat for 1st place between bracketed starters in the same bracket and another starter, the net betting pool for Win Betting shall be divided based on the total number of horses who have finished in the Dead Heat. For the divided betting pool of 3 equal parts, 2 equal parts will be divided among the number of units bets on the starter number of the bracketed starters. The remaining part will be divided among the unit bets of the other starter running the Dead Heat. • Example 2: If there is a dead heat for 1st place between horses No. 10 and 28 who are from the same bracket (i.e. starter No. 10), and horse No. 9 for 1st place, the net betting pool for Win Betting shall be divided into 3 equal parts. 2 of these equal parts will be divided among the number of units bets on starter number 10 (for horses No. 10 and 28). The remaining equal part will be divided among the unit bets on horse No. 9. • In the event of a Dead Heat scenario not provided for above, the various winning combinations / selections shall be derived based on the principles for deriving the winning combinations / selections set out above.
Distribution of Winnings	• The net betting pool for Win Betting (i.e. after deduction of the taxes and commission) shall be divided by the number of unit bets on the winning combination / selection. If your bet is a winning combination / selection, you will be entitled to claim this amount per unit bet as winnings. • For example, if horse No. 4 comes in first in the race, and there were five (5) bets of \$1 placed on horse no. 4, the net betting pool for Win Betting will be divided by the number of unit bets on horse No. 4, i.e. divided by 5.
Unbacked by Bets	• In the event of any winning horse(s) being unbacked by any bets, the net betting pool will be paid out based on the number of unit bets on the 2nd placed horse(s). • If the 2nd placed horse(s) are also unbacked, the net betting pool will be paid out based on the number of unit bets on the 3rd placed horse(s). • If the 3rd placed horse(s) are also unbacked, all bets for Win Betting will be void and refunded.
Insufficient finishers	Should there be no finisher, all bets for Win Betting will be void and refunded.

Void Races	Should the race be declared void, all bets for Win Betting will be void and refunded.
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Appendix A2 - Place Betting

Bet Type	• “Place Betting” refers to the type of betting where (i) you bet that a horse in a race with 7 or more declared starters will finish in either 1st, 2nd or 3rd place, or (ii) where you bet that a horse in a race with 4 to 6 declared starters to finish in either 1st or 2nd place. • For example, in a race of 8 declared starters where horses No. 4, 8 and 10 placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd respectively, you will make a winning selection if you had bet on either horse No. 4, horse No. 8 or horse No. 10.
Winning Selection	• If a bracketed starter places 1st, 2nd or 3rd in the race, the starter number allocated to that bracketed starter will be the winning selection. • This is subject to the provisions on declaration(s) of non-starter, Dead Heat, insufficient finishers and void races below.
Unit Bet	The unit bet for Place Betting is \$5.
Minimum No. of Starters before bet type is offered	In the event of there being fewer than 4 starters in a race, Place Betting will not be offered for the race.
In event of declaration(s) of non-starter	• In the event of any declaration(s) of non-starter, the bets on the non-starter selection(s) (as applicable) will be void and refunded. • In the event that the declaration(s) of non-starter results in there being fewer than four (4) starters in the race, this bet type will cease to be offered for the race, and all bets placed for this bet type will be void and refunded.
Dead Heat	In the event of a Dead Heat for any place which is a winning selection, the net betting pool for Place Betting will be divided first by the number of winning selections, and then further sub-divided into as many equal parts as there are horses which have been backed by bets running the Dead Heat for a winning selection. Each such part shall be divided by the respective number of unit bets on each of such horses. By way of illustration, the allocation of the net betting pool for Place Betting in such a situation is as follows:

	The net betting pool for Place Betting shall be allocated as follows in the stipulated scenarios: (a) Where 2 bracketed starters included in the same bracket finish in i. 1st and 2nd place respectively; ii. 1st and 3rd place respectively; iii. 2nd and 3rd place respectively; iv. A Dead Heat for 1st or 2nd place; v. 1st place and in a Dead Heat for 2nd place with another starter respectively; or vi. A Dead Heat for 1st place with another starter and 3rd place respectively, 2/3 of the net betting pool for Place Betting shall be divided among the number of unit bets on the starter number of the bracketed starters, and the remaining 1/3 of the net betting pool shall be divided by the number of unit bets on the starter number of the other horse which placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd. For example, if horses No. 10 and 28 from the same bracket of starter number 10 run a Dead Heat for the 3rd place and horses No. 11 and 12 finish 1st and 2nd respectively, 1/3 of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be allocated to starter number 10, 1/3 of the net betting pool will be allocated to horse No. 11 and the remaining 1/3 of the net betting pool will be allocated to horse No. 12. (c) Where 2 bracketed starters included in the same bracket finish in a Dead Heat for 1st place with another starter, 2/3 of the net betting pool for Place Betting shall be divided among the number of unit bets on the starter number of the bracketed starters, and the remaining 1/3 will be divided among the number of unit bets on the starter number of the other starter running the Dead Heat for the 1st place. For example, if horses No. 10 and 28 from the same bracket of starter number 10 and horse No. 11 run a Dead Heat for the 1st place, 2/3 of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be allocated to starter number 10 and the remaining 1/3 of the net betting pool will be allocated to horse No. 11. (d) Where 2 bracketed starters included in the same bracket finish in a Dead Heat for 2nd place with another starter, 4/9 of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be divided among the number of unit bets on the starter number of the bracketed starters, and 2/9 of the net betting pool will be divided among the number of unit bets on the
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	starter number of the other starter finishing in the Dead Heat for 2nd place. For example, if horses No. 10 and 28 from the same bracket of starter number 10 and horse No. 9 run a Dead Heat for the 2nd place, with horse No. 12 finishing in the 1st place, $\frac{4}{9}$ of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be allocated to the starter number 10, $\frac{2}{9}$ of the net betting pool will be allocated to horse No. 9, and the remaining $\frac{1}{3}$ of the net betting pool will be allocated to horse No. 12. (e) If 2 bracketed starters included in the same bracket finish in a Dead Heat for 3rd place with another starter, $\frac{2}{9}$ of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be divided among the unit bets on the starter number of the bracketed starters, and $\frac{1}{9}$ of the net betting pool will be divided among the unit bets on the starter number of the other starter finishing in the Dead Heat for 3rd place. For example, if horses No. 10 and 28 from the same bracket of starter number 10 and horse No. 9 run a Dead Heat for the 3rd place, with horses No. 12 and 15 finishing in the 1st place and 2nd place respectively, $\frac{2}{9}$ of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be allocated to the starter number 10, $\frac{1}{9}$ of the net betting pool will be allocated to horse No. 9, and the $\frac{1}{3}$ of the net betting pool will each be allocated to horses No. 12 and 15. (f) If any one of the 2 bracketed starters included in a bracket finishes in 1st or 2nd place, and the other bracketed starter finishes in a Dead Heat for 3rd place with another starter, $\frac{1}{2}$ of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be divided among the number of unit bets on the starter number of the bracketed starters, $\frac{1}{3}$ of the net betting pool will be divided among the unit bets on the starter number finishing in 1st or 2nd place, as the case may be, and $\frac{1}{6}$ of the net betting pool will be divided among the unit bets on the other starter number finishing in 3rd place. For example, if horses No. 10 and 28 from the same bracket of starter number 10 finish respectively in 1st place and a Dead Heat for the 3rd place with horse No. 11, and horse No. 15 finishes in the 2nd place, $\frac{1}{2}$ of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be allocated to the starter number 10, $\frac{1}{3}$ of the net betting pool will be allocated to horse No. 15, and the remaining $\frac{1}{6}$ of the net betting pool will be allocated to horse No. 11. (g) If any one of the 2 bracketed starters included in a bracket finishes in 1st place, and the other bracketed starter finishes in a triple Dead Heat for 2nd place with two other starters, $\frac{5}{9}$ of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be divided among the number of unit bets on the starter number of the 2 bracketed starters, and $\frac{2}{9}$ of the net betting pool will each be divided among the respective number of unit bets on the 2 other starter numbers finishing in the triple Dead Heat for 2nd place.
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	For example, if horses No. 10 and 28 from the same bracket of starter number 10 finish respectively in 1st place and a triple Dead Heat for the 2nd place with horses No. 11 and 15, 5/9 of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be allocated to the starter number 10, and 2/9 of the net betting pool will each be allocated to horses No. 11 and 15. (h) If any one of the 2 bracketed starters included in a bracket finishes in 1st or 2nd place, and the other bracketed starter finishes in a triple Dead Heat for 3rd place with two other starter, 4/9 of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be divided among the number of units on the starter number of the bracketed starters, 1/3 of the net betting pool will be divided among the unit bets on the starter number finishing in 1st or 2nd place, as the case may be, and 1/9 of the net betting pool will each be divided among the respective number of unit bets on the 2 other starter numbers finishing in the triple Dead Heat for 3rd place. For example, if horses No. 10 and 28 from the same bracket of starter number 10 finish respectively in 1st place and a triple Dead Heat for the 3rd place with horses No. 11 and 15, and horse No. 8 finishes in the 2nd place, 4/9 of the net betting pool for Place Betting will be allocated to the starter number 10, 1/3 of the net betting pool will be allocated to horse No. 8, and 1/9 of the net betting pool will each be allocated to horses No. 11 and 15. In the event of a Dead Heat scenario not provided for above, the various winning combinations / selections shall be derived based on the principles for deriving the winning combinations / selections set out above.
Unbacked by Bets	In the event of any winning horse(s) being unbacked by any bets, the net betting pool will be shared by the remaining winning horse(s). If all the winning horses are unbacked by bets, all bets for Place Betting will be void and refunded.
Insufficient finishers	If there are 2 finishers, all bets on the 1st and 2nd horses will be deemed a winning selection, and if there is 1 finisher, all bets on the 1st horse will be deemed a winning selection. Should there be no finisher, all bets for Place Betting will be void and refunded.
Void Races	Should the race be declared void or if there is no finisher, all bets for Place Betting will be void and refunded.

Appendix A3 - Evens and Odds Betting

Bet Type	“Evens and Odds Betting” refers to the type of betting where you have to select the parity of the saddle cloth number (otherwise known as the
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	horse number) of the horse that wins a race. The “parity” of a saddle cloth number indicates whether it is an even number or an odd number. In other words, you’re placing a bet on whether the number of the horse which placed 1st in the race is odd or even.
Winning Selection	• If the saddle cloth number of the first placed horse is an odd number, then the winning selection will be Odds. If the saddle cloth number of the first placed horse is an even number, then the winning selection will be Evens.
Unit Bet	The unit bet for Even and Odds Betting is \$10.
Minimum No. of Starters before bet type is offered	• In the event of there being fewer than four (4) starters in a race, Evens and Odds Betting will not be offered for the race. • In the event of there being four (4) or more starters but only one of which has a saddle cloth number being an even or odd number, Evens and Odds Betting shall not be offered for the race.
In event of declaration(s) of non-starter	• In the event of any declaration(s) of non-starter, your bets will not be refunded unless such non-starter(s) results in the situation mentioned below. • In the event that the declaration(s) of non-starter results in there being fewer than four (4) starters in the race, this bet type will cease to be offered for the race, and all bets placed for this bet type will be void and refunded.
Dead Heat	In the event of a Dead Heat for the 1st place between 2 or more horses which have saddle cloth number being all even numbers or being all odd numbers, the net betting pool for Evens and Odds Betting will be paid out to bets on even numbers or odd numbers respectively. For example, if horses No. 2 and 4 tied for the 1st place, the net betting pool for Evens and Odds Betting shall be paid out to bets on even numbers. In the event of a Dead Heat for the 1st place between a horse or horses which have saddle cloth number being even numbers and a horse(s) which have saddle cloth numbers being odd numbers, all bets for Evens and Odds Betting will be void and refunded. For example, if horses No. 1 and 2 tied for the first place, all bets for Evens and Odds Betting will be void and refunded.
Distribution of Winnings	• The net betting pool for Evens and Odds Betting (i.e. after deduction of taxes and commission) shall be divided by the number of unit bets on the winning selection.

	For example, if Horse No. 3 comes in first in the race, the net betting pool for Evens and Odds Betting will be divided by the number of unit bets on odds.
Unbacked by Bets	In the event that only horses which have saddle cloth numbers being even numbers are backed by bets, or only horses which have saddle cloth numbers being odd numbers are backed by bets, all bets for Evens and Odds Betting will be void and refunded.
Insufficient finishers	Should there be no finisher, all bets for Evens and Odds Betting will be void and refunded.
Void Races	Should the race be declared void, all bets for Evens and Odds Betting will be void and refunded.

Appendix A4 - Forecast Betting

- (c) Where 2 bracketed starters included in the same bracket and another starter finish in a triple Dead Heat for 1st place, 1/3 of the net betting pool for Forecast Betting will be divided among the unit bets on the selection of the starter number of the bracketed starters and any other starter number, and 2/3 of the net betting pool will be divided among the unit bets on the selection of the starter number of the bracketed starter and the other starter number Dead Heating for 1st place.

For example, if horses No. 10 and 28 from the same bracket of starter number 10 finish in a triple Dead Heat for 1st place with horse no. 9, 1/3 of the net betting pool for Forecast Betting will be divided among the unit bets on starter number 10 and any other stater number in the field, and the remaining 2/3 of the net betting pool will be divided among the units bets on the selection of starter number 10 and starter number 9.

For each bet placed, your non-starter horse(s) will be substituted for the next available favourite(s) (as described in Clause 2.2 above) in the leg or legs for the relevant declaration(s) of non-starter, and such favourite(s) shall be deemed to be your original selection. - In the event that the declaration(s) of non-starter results in there being fewer than four (4) starters in any leg, that leg will be declared void.
Dead Heat	In the event of a Dead Heat for the 1st place in any leg of the Six Up Betting, each horse involved in the Dead Heat shall be deemed to have been placed 1st, and will not be deemed to have been placed 2nd. Insufficient finishers	If there are no finishers in one or more legs, the bets selecting the winners of the legs where there are finishers will be deemed a winning selection. If there are no finishers in all the legs, all bets for the Six Up Betting will be void and refunded.
Void Races	The following shall apply in the event of one or more legs being declared void: For a six-leg race: (a) If all races are declared void, all bets for the Six Up Betting will be void and refunded. (b) If 5 legs are declared void, the bets selecting the 1st or 2nd placed horse in the remaining leg will be deemed a winning selection. (c) If 4 legs are declared void, the bets selecting the 1st or 2nd placed horse in the remaining 2 legs will be deemed a winning selection. (d) If 3 legs are declared void, the bets selecting the 1st or 2nd placed horse in the remaining 3 legs will be deemed a winning selection. (e) If 2 legs are declared void, the bets selecting the 1st or 2nd placed horse in the remaining 4 legs will be deemed a winning selection. (f) If 1 leg is declared void, the bets selecting the 1st or 2nd placed horse in the remaining 5 legs will be deemed a winning selection. For a five-leg race: (g) If all races are declared void, all bets for the Six Up Betting will be void and refunded. (h) If 4 legs are declared void, the bets selecting the 1st or 2nd placed horse in the remaining leg will be deemed a winning selection. (i) If 3 legs are declared void, the bets selecting the 1st or 2nd placed horse in the remaining 2 legs will be deemed a winning selection. (j) If 2 legs are declared void, the bets selecting the 1st or 2nd placed horse in the remaining 3 legs will be deemed a winning selection. (k) If 1 leg is declared void, the bets selecting the 1st or 2nd placed horse in the remaining 4 legs will be deemed a winning selection.

Appendix A15 - All Up Betting

Bet Type	“All Up Betting” refers to the system of betting on the Win Betting, Place Betting, Forecast Betting and Place Forecast betting pools where you select a horse or horses in races of your choice, and request Singapore
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	Pools to reinvest any winnings or refund on subsequent races and selections in accordance with your irrevocable instructions and such predetermined formula which we may determine from time to time. In other words, a bet under All Up Betting is a single bet which automatically reinvests your winnings from one race to another.
In event of declaration(s) of non-starter	• In the event of any declaration(s) of non-starter in a race included in a bet for All Up Betting, the bet on a non-starter in a one-leg combination / selection will be void and refunded, while the bet on a non-starter in a multi-leg combination / selection will be carried forward to the next leg. • In the event that the declaration(s) of non-starter results in there being fewer than the minimum of starters required for the bet type, that leg will be declared void.
Other provisions	• Singapore Pools may, at our sole and absolute discretion, limit the amount of any winnings which may be carried forward and tendered as a bet on the remaining subsequent races, which shall be binding on you. You will have no right to claim from us any winnings in respect of any part of the winnings so included in a bet as a result of any such limitation as determined by us from time to time. • In All Up Betting, any winnings or refund on an All Up Betting bet will only be paid after Singapore Pools has declared the results and winnings of all the nominated races under the bet. • Singapore Pools may, at our sole and absolute discretion, determine or revise the formula for All Up Betting and stipulate the number of formulas to be offered for All Up Betting from time to time.

Appendix A16 - Roll Betting

Bet Type	• “Roll Betting” refers to the type of betting where you can roll your bets up to a maximum of 6 races. At present, you may place a bet for Roll Betting on Win Betting (a “Roll Win Bet”). • If you are placing Roll Win Bet, you are essentially placing a bet for the correct selection of the 1st placed horse in multiple races. A unit bet of Roll Win Bet shall be S\$5 unless determined otherwise by Singapore Pools. For example: (a) If you select 2 races, betting on one horse for each race, for one unit of Roll Win Bet (e.g. horse No. 5 for the first race and horse No. 7 for the second race), the cost is S\$5. (b) If you select 3 races, betting on one horse for each race, for one unit of Roll Win Bet (e.g. horse No. 5 for the first race,
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	horse No. 7 for the second race and horse no. 6 for the third race), the cost is also S\$5. (c) If you select 6 races, betting on one horse for each race, for one unit of Roll Win Bet (e.g. horse No. 5 for the first race, horse No. 7 for the second race, horse no. 6 for the third race, horse No. 3 for the fourth race, horse No. 2 for the fifth race and horse No. 1 for the sixth race), the cost is still S\$5. If you are placing Roll Place Bet, you are essentially placing a bet for the correct selection of the 1st, 2nd or 3rd placed horse in multiple races. Similarly, no winnings for a Roll Place Bet shall be paid unless you achieve a winning bet for each and every race that you have placed a bet on, and winnings must be declared to be paid for each and every and all of these races.
Distribution of Winnings	- The winnings for Roll Betting shall be calculated strictly in relation to the winnings declared for Win Betting and Place Betting. - No winnings for a Roll Win Bet shall be paid unless the horses in all of the legs win their respective races. In other words, for Singapore Pools to pay your winnings on your Roll Win Bet, you must have a winning bet for each and every race that you have placed a bet on, and winnings must be declared to be paid for each and every and all of these races. - For example, if you placed a single unit of Roll Win Bet on 2 races and achieved a winning bet for both races, if the 1st leg pays S\$12 and the 2nd leg pays S\$20 as winnings for each unit bet, the winnings payable to you will be calculated as follows: (a) 1 unit bet of S\$5 in the 1st leg results in winnings of S\$12 = 2.40 unit bets (because each unit of Roll Win Bet is S\$5). This will be rolled to the 2nd leg (b) 2.40 unit bets in the 2nd leg results in winnings of $2.40 \text{ units} \times \text{S\\$20} = \text{S\\$48}$ (c) Total winnings payable to you from your unit bet of S\$5 = S\$48 - As another example, if you placed a single unit of Roll Win Bet on 6 races and achieved a winning bet in all 6 races, if the 1st leg pays S\$34, the 2nd leg pays S\$28, the 3rd leg pays S\$10, the 4th leg pays S\$11, the 5th leg pays S\$13 and the 6th leg pays S\$39 as winnings for each unit bet, the winning payable to you will be calculated as follows: (a) 1 unit bet of S\$5 in the 1st leg results in winnings of S\$34 = 6.80 unit bets (because each unit of Roll Win Bet is S\$5). This will be rolled to the 2nd leg (b) 6.80 unit bets in the 2nd leg results in winnings of $6.80 \text{ units} \times \text{S\\$28} = \text{S\\$190} = 38 \text{ units}$ (because each unit of Roll Win Bet is S\$5). This will be rolled to the 3rd leg

	(c) 38 unit bets in the 3rd leg results in winnings of $38 \text{ units} \times S\\$10 = S\\$380 = 76$ (because each unit of Roll Win Bet is S\$5). This will be rolled to the 4th leg (d) 76 unit bets in the 4th leg results in winnings of $76 \text{ units} \times S\\$11 = S\\$836 = 167.20$ unit bets (because each unit of Roll Win Bet is S\$5). This will be rolled to the 5th leg (e) 167.20 unit bets in the 5th leg results in winnings of $167.20 \text{ units} \times S\\$13 = S\\$2,173 = 434.60$ unit bets (because each unit of Roll Win Bet is S\$5). This will be rolled to the 6th leg (f) 434.60 unit bets in the 6th leg results in winnings of $434.60 \text{ units} \times S\\$39 = S\\$16,949$ Total winning payable to you from your unit bet of S\$5 = S\$16,949
Refunds	Refunds for any declaration(s) of non-starter, abandoned races or races declared as void shall be at the sole and absolute discretion of Singapore Pools. Such refunds, <u>if any</u>, shall be dealt with in the following manner for the stipulated scenarios: (a) If a refund is declared on the horse for the 1st leg, all bets on the horse for the 1st leg will be rolled on to the horses for the subsequent legs of your bet for Roll Betting (whether a Roll Win Bet or Roll Place Bet) for which a refund has not been declared. (b) If you have placed a bet for Roll Betting on 6 races (whether a Roll Win Bet or Roll Place Bet) and achieved a winning bet in the 1st leg, but a refund is declared on any of the horses for the subsequent legs, the winnings payable on the 1st leg and subsequent legs prior to the leg for which a refund is declared shall be rolled on to the horses for the subsequent legs for which a refund has not been declared. (c) If you have achieved a winning bet in the 1st leg for your bet on Roll Betting (whether a Roll Win Bet or Roll Place Bet), and there are refunds declared on all subsequent legs of your bet, you shall be paid the winnings declared for your winning bet in the 1st leg.
