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NOTICE ON DICE

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Pursuant to regulation 20(2) of the Casino Control (Gaming Equipment) Regulations 2009, gaming equipment for use in any casino shall comply with:
 - a. the Existing Notice (Version 4.0) until the Date of Cessation (inclusive); and
 - b. the New Notice (Version 5.0) from the Date of Commencement (inclusive).
- 1.2 All terms used in this notice, unless the context otherwise requires or otherwise defined, shall have the same meanings as in the Casino Control Act 2006 (the “Act”) and any regulations made thereunder as may be amended from time to time.
- 1.3 Any reference to legislation refers to such legislation as may be amended from time to time.

2. UNDERLYING PRINCIPLES

- 2.1 The evaluation of gaming equipment serves to ensure that the operation of a casino is and remains free from criminal influence or exploitation and that casino gambling and promotional games in a casino is conducted honestly.
- 2.2 Hence, all gaming equipment must be designed and manufactured to allow operations of a casino to be conducted in a manner that is honest, secure, auditable and reliable.

3. REQUIREMENTS FOR DICE

- 3.1 The weight of the dice shall be equally distributed throughout the dice and no side shall be heavier or lighter than any other side.
- 3.2 The dice shall be in the shape of a perfect cube where all sides have equal dimensions and all corners are identical.
- 3.3 Each side of the dice shall be perfectly flat with identical texture and finish.
- 3.4 The markings on each side of the dice shall be perfectly flushed with the area surrounding them, with no other indentation or embossing.
- 3.5 Dice to be handled by patrons shall be transparent except for the spots, serial number, letters or any form of artwork that would indicate that the dice belong to a particular casino operator contained thereon.
- 3.6 The dice shall bear a unique identifying feature of a casino operator or any other form of artwork that would indicate that the dice belong to a particular casino operator.

4. GENERAL

- 4.1 For the avoidance of doubt:-
- a. the contents of this document do not in any way affect the requirement for approval, if any, from the Authority under the Act or the regulations or rules made thereunder and any applicable laws;
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
