

Singapore Sweep Game Rules w.e.f. 22 April 2026, 00:00 hrs



In accordance with Section 70(1) of the Gambling Control Act 2022, the Gambling Regulatory Authority of Singapore approves the game rules in respect of the game “Singapore Sweep” as set out in this document by Singapore Pools (Private) Limited.

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GAME RULES FOR THE SINGAPORE SWEEP LOTTERY ("SINGAPORE SWEEP GAME RULES")

The following Rules are laid down by Singapore Pools (Private) Limited ("Singapore Pools") for The Singapore Sweep Lottery.

1. Objective

- 1.1 The Singapore Sweep Lottery is a 7-digit sweepstakes game where you purchase a lottery ticket containing a 7-digit number between 1000000 and 4499999 (both numbers inclusive) for a particular draw. To qualify for a winning prize, some or all of the digits of the 7-digit number on your lottery ticket must correctly match one or more of the winning combinations drawn during the particular draw for which your lottery ticket is valid as explained at Sections 2 and 4 below.

2. How to Play

- 2.1 To play the Singapore Sweep Lottery, you are essentially placing a bet on a 7-digit number from 1000000 to 4499999. If all 7 digits or the last 2 digits of your selected 7-digit number are identical to the 7-digit or 2-digit numbers drawn by Singapore Pools (known as the respective winning numbers), you will win a prize.

A. Types of Entry

- 2.2 To participate in the Singapore Sweep Lottery, you are required to place a wager or an "**Entry**" to the game. The types of Entries that may be offered by Singapore Pools at any point of time for you to purchase to participate in the Singapore Sweep Lottery shall be at the sole and absolute discretion of Singapore Pools. We shall be entitled to add to, remove or modify the types of Entries available for participation in the Singapore Sweep Lottery as and when we deem fit. At present, the types of Entries that may be offered by Singapore Pools for you to purchase to participate in the Singapore Sweep Lottery comprise the following:

Quick Pick: Purchase a single 7-digit number randomly generated for you by the Singapore Pools system.

100 Numbers: Purchase 100 7-digit numbers whose first 5 digits are identical and randomly generated for you by the Singapore Pools system, with each of the last 2 digits being a number within the range of 00 to 99.

Example: The system randomly generates 5 digits "3", "1", "4", "2" and "6". Your wager consists of the 100 numbers starting from 3142600 to 3142699.

First Digit: Purchase a single 7-digit number in which you select the first digit, with the remaining 6 digits being randomly generated for you by the Singapore Pools system.

Last 4 Digits: Purchase a single 7-digit number in which you select last 4 digits, with the first 3 digits being randomly generated for you by the Singapore Pools system.

3. Purchasing your Ticket

- 3.1 You may purchase your Singapore Sweep Lottery ticket(s) which contains details of your wager from our betting outlets and our authorised retailers and their appointed vendors. All four (4) types of Entries are available for purchase at the aforesaid locations. Some authorised retailers may offer only Quick Pick and 100 Numbers Entries, while other authorised retailers and all vendors appointed by our authorised retailers may only sell pre-printed Quick Pick tickets. You may wish to inquire with the authorised retailer about the types of Entry that it offers prior to purchase of your ticket.
- 3.2 Tickets may be purchased as early as from the end of the previous Singapore Sweep Lottery draw until half an hour before the draw in respect of the ticket purchased is conducted.
- 3.3 If a bet is successfully placed at betting outlets and authorised retailers, you will receive a lottery ticket, which will serve as proof that your bet has been validly placed.
- 3.4 Singapore Pools has the full discretion to determine the maximum number of bets that you may place for each Singapore Sweep Lottery draw from time to time. At the time of placing your bets, you will only be able to place up to this determined maximum number of bets.
- 3.5 The amount of money payable for each lottery ticket entitling a single entry to and participation in a draw, shall be three (3) Singapore dollars, inclusive of Goods and Services Tax (GST). The amount of money payable for each lottery ticket entitling a “100 Numbers” entry to and participation in a draw, shall be three hundred (300) Singapore dollars, inclusive of GST.

4. Matching of Winning Combinations and Prize Money

- 4.1 To determine the winning numbers for each Singapore Sweep Game, Singapore Pools will draw:
- (a) 133 sets of seven (7) numbers from 1000000 to 4499999 (both numbers inclusive); and
 - (b) 9 sets of two (2) numbers from 00 to 99
- 4.2 Each set of seven (7) numbers or two (2) numbers (as the case may be) will be drawn one set at a time, and shall be drawn in the following order (from the first to be drawn to the last to be drawn):
- (a) 9 sets of two (2) numbers for the Two-Digit Delight Prizes.
 - (b) 50 sets of seven (7) numbers for the Participation Prizes.
 - (c) 30 sets of seven (7) numbers for the Consolation Prizes.
 - (d) 30 sets of seven (7) numbers for the Gift Prizes.
 - (e) 10 sets of seven (7) numbers for the Lucky Prizes.
 - (f) 10 sets of seven (7) numbers for the Jackpot Prizes.
 - (g) 1 set of seven (7) numbers for the Third Prize.
 - (h) 1 set of seven (7) numbers for the Second Prize.
 - (i) 1 set of seven (7) numbers for the First Prize.
- 4.3 These 133 sets of seven (7) numbers and 9 sets of two (2) numbers shall constitute the winning numbers for the particular draw of the Singapore Sweep Game.
- 4.4 Official information on the results of Singapore Sweep Lottery draws will be released by us on the Singapore Pools website and mobile app. Singapore Pools reserves the right to rectify any errors discovered after the official information has been released on the Singapore Pools website and mobile app, and the results of the relevant draw (including the amounts of prizes declared for the draw) will be as stated in the latest rectified versions on such website and mobile app. Otherwise, the results of the relevant draw (including the amounts of prizes for the draw) shall be as announced on the Singapore Pools website and mobile app at the end of the relevant draw.
- 4.5 There are two types of matches which will allow your lottery ticket to win a prize or prizes:

- (a) the 7-digit number of the ticket number on your lottery ticket matches with one or more of the 7-digit winning combinations drawn during the relevant draw; and
- (b) the last two digits of the ticket number on your lottery ticket matches with one or more of the winning 2-digit combinations drawn during the relevant draw.

4.6 For every draw, there are different types of prizes with different prize amounts awarded. To achieve a particular type of prize, your ticket number must match the winning combination(s) drawn for that particular type of prize. Each type of prize will have a specific number of winning combinations that will be drawn during the draw.

4.7 The type of prizes, the number of winning combinations for a particular type of prize and the prize amounts of each type of prize for any draw, unless otherwise prescribed and notified by SPPL for specific draws, shall be as described below:

Type of Prize	Number of Winning Combinations	Prize Amount
First Prize	One 7-digit number	\$ 2,300,000
Second Prize	One 7-digit number	\$ 500,000
Third Prize	One 7-digit number	\$ 250,000
Jackpot Prizes	Ten 7-digit numbers	\$ 10,000 each
Lucky Prizes	Ten 7-digit numbers	\$ 5,000 each
Gift Prizes	Thirty 7-digit numbers	\$ 3,000 each
Consolation Prizes	Thirty 7-digit numbers	\$ 2,000 each
Participation Prizes	Fifty 7-digit numbers	\$ 1,000 each
Two-Digit Delight Prizes	Three hundred & fifteen thousand 2-digit numbers	\$ 6 each

4.8 Your lottery ticket may win more than one type of prize if the ticket number has more than one winning match. Should your lottery ticket win more than one prize, you shall be entitled to get all such prizes.

5. Irregularities

- 5.1 Refunds are not available for any purchase of a Singapore Sweep Lottery ticket, save that if a force majeure event occurs, we may at our sole and absolute discretion either choose to refund the price paid, or postpone the relevant Singapore Sweep Lottery draw to a later date in which event no refunds will be given. We will only grant refunds if we are satisfied at our sole and absolute discretion that your claim is valid. Where there is any non-compliance of regulatory requirements in respect of a particular draw, such draw may be postponed but no refunds will be issued.

For purposes of this clause, a force majeure event refers to any event beyond the reasonable control of Singapore Pools, including but not limited to strikes and labour disputes, accidents, war, invasion, riot, rebellion, civil commotion, insurrection, fire, flood, high winds, lightning, changes in law, national or state emergencies or other governmental actions, epidemic, disease, explosion, act of God or embargoes.

- 5.2 Where there is evidence of any rigging of any Singapore Sweep Lottery draw, we reserve the right to do any or all of the following:

- (a) Delay the announcement of the results of the affected draws;
- (b) Withhold payment of the relevant prizes pending the outcome of any investigation into the suspected rigging;
- (c) Withhold payment of the relevant prizes pending verification of the suspected rigging;
- (d) Declare bets on the relevant draw as void. In such an event, all bets for the relevant draw shall be refunded.

- 5.3 If a fault or failure occurs in the equipment used for a draw in the course of the draw or any other intervening event occurs in the course of the draw which disrupts the draw process, Singapore Pools shall have absolute discretion to determine the validity of the draw, and may do any of the following:

- (a) Singapore Pools may declare that any and all numbers that have been drawn prior to the equipment fault / failure or the intervening event were duly and validly drawn. If the complete set of numbers required for the draw have not been drawn at the time of the equipment fault / failure or the intervening event, Singapore Pools may continue the draw process, whether using the same equipment or otherwise;
- (b) Singapore Pools may declare that any and all numbers that have been drawn prior to the equipment fault / failure or the intervening event were not validly drawn, and conduct a new draw process afresh, whether using the same equipment or otherwise; or

- (c) Singapore Pools may declare that the draw is void, in which case the draw shall be treated as if it has never taken place, and all bets shall be refunded.
- 5.4 Where any error or miscalculation of any prize is discovered at any time, Singapore Pools shall be empowered at our sole and absolute discretion to declare a revised prize.
- 5.5 Where a revised prize is declared by Singapore Pools in respect of your winning lottery ticket:
 - (a) If you have not previously been paid a prize in respect of your winning lottery ticket, you shall be paid the full revised prize.
 - (b) Where you have been paid the original prize and the revised prize is higher in value than the original prize, you shall be entitled to claim the difference between the original prize and the revised prize, subject to any reasonable conditions of payment which Singapore Pools may impose at our sole and absolute discretion.
 - (c) If you have failed to present yourself for the collection of the revised prize or the difference between the original prize and the revised prize by the expiration of the time specified by Singapore Pools as stated on the Singapore Pools website and mobile app for the payment of the revised prize, or have otherwise failed to present the lottery ticket or to accept our conditions of payment (if any), the unclaimed revised prize or difference shall be forfeited.
 - (d) Where you have been paid the original prize and the revised prize is lower in value than the original prize, Singapore Pools shall be entitled to recover the difference from you.

6. General Provisions

- 6.1 These Singapore Sweep Lottery Game Rules shall apply to Singapore Sweep Draw No. 1090/2026 and all subsequent Singapore Sweep draws where Singapore Pools draws the winning numbers for a draw.
- 6.2 By purchasing a Singapore Sweep Lottery ticket, you agree to be bound by these Singapore Sweep Lottery Game Rules.
