

4D Game Rules

In accordance with Section 70(1) of the Gambling Control Act 2022, the Gambling Regulatory Authority of Singapore approves the game rules in respect of the game “4D” as set out in this document by Singapore Pools (Private) Limited.

GAME RULES FOR THE 4D GAME (“4D GAME RULES”)

The following Rules are laid down by Singapore Pools (Private) Limited (“Singapore Pools”, “we”, “us” or “our”) for the 4D Game.

1. Objective

1.1 The 4D Game is a 4-digit lottery game where you purchase a lottery ticket containing a 4-digit number between 0000 and 9999 (both numbers inclusive) for a particular draw. A lottery ticket includes both physical tickets issued offline at our betting outlets, as well as digital records and e-tickets issued for bets placed via remote betting. To qualify for a winning prize, your selected 4-digit number on your lottery ticket must correctly match one or more of the winning combinations drawn during the particular draw for which your lottery ticket is valid.

2. How to Play

A. Types of Entry

2.1 To play the 4D Game, you are placing a bet, otherwise referred to as an “Entry”, on a 4-digit number from 0000 to 9999. If your selected 4-digit number is identical to the number drawn by Singapore Pools, known as the winning number, you will win a prize.

2.2 When placing your bet, there are two things that you have to decide: (1) whether your Entry is “Big” or “Small”; and (2) the type of Entry that you want to place.

2.3 There are five categories of prizes, namely First, Second, Third, Starter and Consolation, with 4-digit number (s) being drawn for each category:

Prize Category	Number of 4-digit numbers drawn
First Prize	One 4-digit number
Second Prize	One 4-digit number
Third Prize	One 4-digit number
Starter Prizes	Ten 4-digit numbers
Consolation prizes	Ten 4-digit numbers

2.4 Where your Entry is “Big”, you are placing a bet that your selected 4-digit number matches the winning 4-digit numbers in any of the five categories of prize. Where your Entry is “Small”, you are placing a bet that your selected 4-digit number matches the winning 4-digit numbers in the First, Second or Third categories of

prizes only. Therefore, whether your bet is “Big” or “Small” will affect your odds of winning any prize and the corresponding prize amount.

2.5 There are four different types of Entry that you may purchase to participate in the 4D Game:

Ordinary Entry: Place a bet on a selected 4-digit number from 0000 – 9999. You will win when your selected 4-digit number on your lottery ticket matches the winning number in the exact same order.

Example: You place a bet on 5284. If the winning number for First Prize is 5284, you will win First Prize. If one of the winning numbers for a Starter Prize is 5284, you will win a Starter Prize.

4D Roll Entry: Place a bet on only 3 out of the 4 digits of a 4-digit number. Of the 4 digits, you will only need to select 3 digits and the order in which they are arranged in a 4-digit number. You will win if the 3 digits and their order in the 4-digital number match the 3 digits in the exact same order in the winning numbers, regardless of what the unselected digit is.

Example: You select the 3 digits “5”, “8” and “2” and arrange them in the following order 58X2. You will win if the winning numbers are any or all of the following ten permutations: 5802, 5812, 5822, 5832, 5842, 5852, 5862, 5872, 5882 and 5892.

System Entry: Place a bet on all the possible permutations of a selected 4-digit number from 0000 – 9999, save for the numbers with only a single permutation, i.e. 0000, 1111, 2222, 3333, 4444, 5555, 6666, 7777, 8888 and 9999. For example, if the 4-digit number you have chosen is “1234”, you will be placing a bet on all the possible combinations of “1234”. You will win when your selected 4-digit on your lottery ticket matches the winning number, regardless of whether the order is the same.

iBet Entry: Place a bet on all the possible permutations of a selected 4-digit number from 0000 – 9999, save for the numbers with only a single permutation, i.e. 0000, 1111, 2222, 3333, 4444, 5555, 6666, 7777, 8888 and 9999. This is essentially the same as a System Entry, but with different bet amounts and winning prizes payable. You will win when your selected 4-digit on your lottery ticket matches the winning number, regardless of whether the order is the same.

For each Entry, you are required to select numbers to form the 4-digit number. You may choose to select these numbers yourself, or allow the numbers to be selected randomly by Singapore Pools' computer system (otherwise known as "**Quick Pick**" option).

2.6 Singapore Pools shall, from time to time and at our sole and absolute discretion, determine the Entries that are available for your participation in the 4D Game.

3. Placing your bets

3.1 The amount of money payable for each lottery ticket entitling a single entry to and participation in a draw, shall be one (1) Singapore dollar or multiples of one (1) Singapore dollar, inclusive of Goods and Services Tax (GST).

3.2 You are able to place your bets for the 4D Game either (a) physically at our betting outlets or with our authorised retailers; or (b) remotely through our website or mobile app.

3.3 Bets may be placed before the conduct of the 4D Game draw. Singapore Pools may offer betting up to fifteen (15) days, or such shorter time as determined by Singapore Pools, prior to the conduct of the relevant 4D Game draw until the prescribed time for the closure of the bet placement period as may be determined by Singapore Pools in its sole and absolute discretion. If a bet is successfully placed at betting outlets and authorised retailers, you will receive a lottery ticket, which will serve as proof that your bet has been validly placed. If a bet is successfully placed through your verified account that is opened and operated by Singapore Pools for the purpose of remote betting ("**Remote Betting Account**") via the Singapore Pools website and mobile app, you will receive a confirmation that your bet has been successfully placed. The bet will be recorded in your Remote Betting Account, and such record will serve as proof that your bet has been validly placed. Your bet will be deemed to be valid and accepted by Singapore Pools only if full payment has been made for the requisite stake amount for your bet. If such full payment is not made, the bet will be invalid and rejected by Singapore Pools.

3.4 We are unable to guarantee the availability of your bets for the 4D Game. Where the stake for the bet that you wish to place for a particular number will result in the total stake for all bets for that number exceeding the maximum stake that can be accepted for that particular number ("**Threshold**"), thereby resulting in that particular number being sold out, your bet will automatically be placed for the value of the stake that will result in the total stake for all bets for that number meeting but not exceeding the Threshold. The Threshold for each number for each draw will be determined by Singapore Pools in our full discretion.

3.5 Singapore Pools has the full discretion to determine the maximum number of bets that you may place for each 4D Game draw from time to time. At the time of placing your bets, you will only be able to place up to this determined maximum number of bets.

3.6 Singapore Pools has full discretion to determine from time to time, the maximum and minimum limits of the stake that you may place, as well as any other conditions

attached to such stake, as may be notified to you through the Singapore Pools website or mobile app.

4. Matching of Winning Combinations and Prize Money

4.1 To determine the winning numbers for each 4D Game draw, Singapore Pools may either:

- a) Draw four (4) numbers from 0 to 9 (both numbers inclusive) one at a time which will constitute a set of 4D winning numbers for the particular draw of the 4D Game; or
- b) Adopt the last four digits of the winning numbers of the 1st prize, 2nd prize, 3rd prize, ten Jackpot prizes and ten Lucky prizes of the Singapore Sweep Lottery as the corresponding winning numbers of the 1st prize, 2nd prize, 3rd prize, ten Starter prizes and ten Consolation prizes for the 4D Game.

Singapore Pools has full discretion over the decision on how the winning numbers of each 4D game draw are to be decided. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, Singapore Pools may determine the winning numbers of each 4D Game draw by using the method at Clause 4.1(b) above when the 4D Game draw takes place on the same day as a Singapore Sweep Lottery draw.

4.2 Official information on the results of the relevant 4D Game draw will be released by us on the Singapore Pools website and mobile app. Singapore Pools reserves the right to rectify any errors discovered after the official information has been released on our website and mobile app, and the results of the draw (including the amounts of prizes declared for the draw) will be as stated in the latest rectified version. Otherwise, the results of the relevant draw (including the amounts of prizes for the draw) shall be as announced on the Singapore Pools website and mobile app at the end of the relevant draw.

4.3 To qualify for a winning prize, your selected 4-digit number on your lottery ticket must correctly match one or more of the winning numbers for the particular draw for which your lottery ticket is valid.

4.4 The number of 4-digit prize winners and the prize amounts vary due to several factors:

- a) The type of entry for the 4D Game, e.g. whether it is (i) an Ordinary, 4D Roll and System Entry or (ii) an iBet Entry; and/or
- b) Whether your bet is “Big” or “Small”.

4.5 The prize structures for any draw of the 4D Game, including the type of prizes, the number of winning numbers for a particular type of prize and the prize amount for every \$1 stake for each type, are as described below:

4.6 If your selected 4-digit number(s) has more than one winning match, you shall be entitled to get all such prizes.

5. Irregularities

5.1 Refunds are not available for any purchases made in respect of the 4D Game, save that if a force majeure event occurs, we may at our sole and absolute discretion choose to either refund the stake paid, or postpone the relevant 4D Game draw to a later date in which event no refunds will be given. We will only grant refunds if we are satisfied at our sole and absolute discretion that your claim is valid. Where there is any non-compliance of regulatory requirements in respect of a particular draw, such draw may be postponed but no refunds will be issued.

For purposes of this clause, a force majeure event refers to any event beyond the reasonable control of Singapore Pools, including but not limited to strikes and labour disputes, accidents, war, invasion, riot, rebellion, civil commotion, insurrection, fire, flood, high winds, lightning, changes in law, national or state emergencies or other governmental actions, epidemic, disease, explosion, act of God or embargoes.

5.2 Where there is evidence of any rigging of any draw which is the subject of any bet placed with Singapore Pools, we reserve the right to do any or all of the following:

- a) Delay the announcement of the results of the affected draws.
- b) Withhold payment of the relevant prizes pending the outcome of any investigation into the suspected rigging.
- c) Withhold payment of the relevant prizes pending verification of the suspected rigging.
- d) Declare bets on the relevant draw as void. In such an event, all bets for the relevant draw shall be refunded.

5.3 If a fault or failure occurs in the equipment used for a draw in the course of the draw or any other intervening event occurs in the course of the draw which disrupts the draw process, Singapore Pools shall have absolute discretion to determine the validity of the draw, and may do any of the following:

- a) Singapore Pools may declare that any and all numbers that have been drawn prior to the equipment fault / failure or the intervening event were duly and validly drawn. If the complete set of numbers required for the draw have not been drawn at the time of the equipment fault / failure or the intervening event, Singapore Pools may continue the draw process, whether using the same equipment or otherwise;.
- b) Singapore Pools may declare that any and all numbers that have been drawn prior to the equipment fault / failure or the intervening event were not

validly drawn, and conduct a new draw process afresh, whether using the same equipment or otherwise; or

- c) Singapore Pools may declare that the draw is void, in which case the draw shall be treated as if it has never taken place, and all bets shall be refunded.

5.4 Where any error or miscalculation of any prize is discovered at any time, Singapore Pools shall be empowered at our sole and absolute discretion to declare a revised prize.

5.5 Where a revised prize is declared by Singapore Pools in respect of your winning lottery ticket:

- a) If you have not previously been paid a prize in respect of your winning lottery ticket, you shall be paid the full revised prize.
- b) Where you have been paid the original prize and the revised prize is higher in value than the original prize, you shall be entitled to claim the difference between the original prize and the revised prize, subject to any reasonable conditions of payment which Singapore Pools may impose at our sole and absolute discretion.
- c) If you have failed to present yourself for the collection of the revised prize or the difference between the original prize and the revised prize by the expiration of the time specified by Singapore Pools for the payment of the revised prize, or otherwise failed to adequately identify yourself to our satisfaction or to accept our conditions of payment (if any), the unclaimed revised prize or difference shall be forfeited.
- d) Where you have been paid the original prize and the revised prize is lower in value than the original prize, Singapore Pools shall be entitled to recover the difference from you.

6. General Provisions

6.1 These 4D Game Rules shall apply to 4D Game Draw No. 5269/2024 and all subsequent 4D Game draws where Singapore Pools draws the winning numbers for a draw, and shall apply to 4D Game Draw No. 5269/2024 and all subsequent 4D Game draws where Singapore Pools adopts the winning numbers of the Singapore Sweep Lottery as the winning numbers for a draw.

6.2 By placing a bet for the 4D Game, you agree to be bound by these 4D Game Rules.
