1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Under Regulation 2 of the Casino Control (Advertising) Regulations 2010 that was in force on 25 November 2016, designated tourist attraction means “a place designated as a tourist attraction and listed on the official website of the Authority at <https://www.cra.gov.sg> as such”.
- 1.2 This document is a re-issue of the list of designated tourist attractions that was in effect from 25 November 2016. The list of designated tourist attractions has been superseded on 26 January 2024.
- 1.3 The list of designated tourist attractions that was in effect from 25 November 2016 is being re-issued to include a cover page, a reference number and other important information. The content of the original document remains unchanged and is found in the **Annex**.
- 1.4 All terms used in this document, unless the context otherwise requires or otherwise defined, shall have the same meanings as in the Casino Control Act 2006 and any regulations made thereunder.
